Focus Landscapes Project: Reconnecting with Nature

This Project is still in progress. 'Threatened woodland birds of the Goulburn-Murray irrigation district' involves surveying endangered Grey-crowned Babbler, Bush Stone-crowlew and Superb Parrot numbers to determine their distribution and see what effect these works had on the birds' populations. We are keen to hear of any landholders who might have these birds on their property and would like some \$\$ to assist with fencing off some remnant vegetation, old trees and retain fallen logs as habitat for these birds

Please help protect the few remaining populations in the Landscape. Leave fallen logs for the Curlews, leave large trees for the Babbler and create habitat and food sources for the Superb Parrot.


Goulburn Broken Catchment Management Authority have launched a new phone app so you can easily identify and record the "critters" that you find in your travel around the catchment.

SOILS NEWS

beyond soilcare

Soil health is getting more coverage not than ever before & no wonder - beneath our feet is a dynamic diverse living system that is essential to how we live.

As land managers we can benefit from learning more about the 'underground livestock' & how their actions can make our work efficient & more productive.

Soil biology includes bacteria, fungi, protozoa, nematodes, beetles, mites, spiders & earthworms. The nutrient cycle is complex & involves multiple processes. This is called the soil food web.



A healthy food web occurs when diverse organisms are present & functioning. Nutrients are then able to be accessed by plants when they need them. There is a complex relationship between plants and biology which have the following functions:

- Retention of nutrients so not lost as vapour or locked up.
- Nutrient cycling in the right forms & rates for the plants
- Building soil structure, aiding oxygen, water & nutrient absorption
- Breakdown of organic matter
- Promoting plant healthy growth
