

FUNDING OPPORTUNITY

Regional Riparian Action Plan Riparian Landcare Incentive Program 2019/20

Through funding from the State Government, the Regional Riparian Action Plan Riparian Landcare Incentive Program provides project grants to non-profit community groups, such as Landcare groups and networks and Conservation Management Networks (CMN's), in the Goulburn Broken Catchment. The funding will be provided to community groups for the planning and implementation of on-ground riparian actions on priority waterways and wetlands in the Goulburn Broken Waterway Strategy (2014- 2022) and/or waterways of "community priority". This funding round has \$45,000 available, with the expectation that funding will be allocated to 2-3 grants, depending on the quality and alignment to the funding guidelines of the applications lodged. The grant round opens 9am Tuesday 4th December 2018 and **closes 5pm Friday 1st February 2019**. Applications are to be made online through the Goulburn Broken CMA Online Project Portal.
