The plantation along the road frontage is a mix of Red Ironbark - *E tricarpa*, Yellow gum - *leucoxylon* and *Melaleuca species*, established in 1998.

There are a number of naturall occuring native grasses and groundcover species at this site. They include Spider grass - Enteropogon acicularis, Windmill grass - Chloris truncata, Wallaby grasses - Austrodanthonia sp, and Spear grasses - Austrostipa sp. There is also Black cottonbush - Maireana decalvans and Creeping Saltbush - Atriplex semibaccata.
